The Student

I will

- Endeavour to attend college every day, be at registration and lessons on time in correct uniform and with the necessary equipment.
- Abide by the rules of the college.

COLLEGE RULES

- 1 To treat the people and property in our college community with care and consideration at all times.
- 2 To arrive promptly in full college uniform and with the appropriate equipment.
- 3 To listen to and follow instructions.
- 4 To work to the best of your ability without disturbing others.
- 5 To treat everyone with courtesy.
- 6 To do nothing which could be deemed threatening or offensive to others.
- 7 To bring nothing illegal or dangerous into college, nor any other items which might be injurious to the health and well being of themselves and other members of the college community.
- 8 Not to leave the premises without permission.
- 9 I understand that I am allowed to wear one finger ring, a watch and one pair of stud earrings only. That these are my responsibility and I will remove them in areas where health and safety are paramount.
- 10 I will not wear any make up in Key Stage 3 (Years 7,8,9). In Key Stage 4 (Years 10 & 11) I will only use natural make up as this is permitted.
